

# Destination Data 2024 to 2026

## Key Insights to 24/25 Data:

- The largest proportion of leavers go to mainstream vocational colleges (53%)
- Academic levels show a majority at Level 2/1 with fewer students completing Level 3
- West Kirby Post 16 is the main post-16 destination for Year 11s, with 45% of pupils remaining
- NEET numbers this year are slightly lower than the national average (12.5%), it reinforces the need for some need for targeted support to be developed
- Transition rates are generally high for older students, particularly those in Years 13–14.
- A significant portion of Year 12 students remain in WKS Post 16 (77%), showing continuation within the school's own provision.

## Key Insights over the last six years:

- Most leavers go to mainstream vocational colleges or specialist colleges (72% combined)
- Specialist colleges account for 26%, showing a significant proportion of students require additional support and a nurturing environment
- NEET numbers are relatively low at 11%, but consistent over time
- Very few students transition directly into employment or self-employment (4%)
- Most leavers are at Level 2 or Level 1, with a smaller number reaching Level 3.
