Dear Parents and Carers,

Following a really busy end of term I can tell you the following:

Good news!

Uniform details:

Pupils in Y7, Y10 and any new pupils will have been given a new school tie in the colour for their year group:

Y7, Y8, Y9	Blue tie
Y10, Y11	Gold tie

Please ensure that your child returns to school wearing uniform in September. This can be:

- Black trousers, shorts, skirt, or joggers (no logo)
- White shirt, polo or t-shirt (no logo)
- A school tie (optional)
- A blazer is optional and can be bought from the school office
- PE kit is supplied (first kit free!) by school. This is also black and white.
- In all cases footwear should be plain black, without logos

No logos on shirts, t-shirts or joggers. Hoodies, black jumpers or cardigans can also be worn and should be logo free, unless this is the WKS flag.

The purpose of our uniform (which was lobbied for and chosen by pupils) is to share a sense of team work and belonging. We like our pupils to look the part.

Pupils in Post 16 don't need to wear uniform, but can wear suitable practical or smart clothing of their choice (nothing skimpy, no offensive slogans, no flips flops).
