Improve the sustainability of the school	Mr Cowell is creating a water, energy and recycling plan to improve these areas. We aim to increase the amount of school grown produce into our canteen food
Develop ways to prevent child on child abuse (This includes unkind banter, bullying, being mean)	Mr Smith is working with the Pastoral Care Team to support pupils on this. We are also working towards our Anti-Bullying Quality Mark Award and developing our whole school positive mental health support.
Promote STEM throughout school and the wider community	Mrs Wilkinson is leading on this by developing STEM lunch clubs, establishing community & school links for STEM workshops; and creating more Enterprise opportunities within the curriculum.
Develop pupil ownership and awareness of safeguarding in Post 16	Mr Hulme is leading on this by creating a team of Young Ambassadors to develop safeguarding and anti-bullying practices and strategies
