

## Destination & NEET Data 2020 to 2022

### Overview:

Over the past three years, we have had 5 pupils who have been NEET, this equates to 12% of the total school leavers from West Kirby School and College in the last three years. On average, this breaks down to 1.7 pupils per academic year leaving Year 11 and Post 16.

### Prevention:

- **Person Centred Transition Planning** – working with the pupils, parents and WKS whole staff team we prepare our pupils to make informed decisions for their future, we support them into the next destination and we pre-empt the barriers or issues that may appear. We start this process in year 10, right the way through to Post 16. From teachers to support staff to clinical team to PCT, we work together to support the individual to their next destination.
- **Parents** – We keep in touch via telephone or email with parents and pupils for at least 12 months, offering advice and support.
- **Liaising with multi-disciplinary agencies** - support workers/social workers (if a LAC), Local Authorities and external partners such as, Career Wales, Sefton at Work, Liverpool in Work, Career Connect
- **Liaising with colleges and training providers** - If a placement is breaking down, we liaise with the training provider to help mediate or to help resolve any issues.
- **Home visits** – taking them to lunch, going for a walk or doorstep chats
- **WKS staff contact** – we ask staff who the pupil trusts to ring or make contact. We also utilise their peers and our whole staff to keep in touch and invite ex-pupils in to Post 16 for lunch or events
- **College visits** – arranging to meet at lunch time with WKS staff e.g. PCT / Post 16 staff or arranging a school visit for pupils to be when we know the ex-pupil will be in college.
- **Accompanying ex-pupils** - visits for volunteer placements, training providers, employer visits
- **Employment Support and signposting** – assisting with job searching and assisting with applications, producing CVs & covering letters, offering to take them to interviews

We will respond to any communication with past pupils and parents, regardless of when they left to provide any advice, guidance and support.
