LAST YEAR WE ASKED YOU WHAT YOU THINK WE SHOULD IMPROVE....




You said we should:	We did:
Improve the sustainability of the school	We created a recycling plan, increased the amount of school grown produce in our canteen and improved our signage so you know what we are doing.
Develop ways to prevent child on child abuse (This includes unkind banter, bullying, being mean)	We achieved the Gold Trauma and Attachment Award, demonstrating that we have good processes in place. We also have appointed Mr Cox as a Behaviour Champion.
Promote STEM throughout school and the wider community	We increased our Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths activities and we are setting up a Science Hub to link with local schools for more ideas.
Develop pupil ownership and awareness of safeguarding in Post 16	Mr Hulme has arranged for pupils to be trained as Young Ambassadors, developing safeguarding and anti- bullying practices.
Develop the ICT room for use in ICT lessons and as a study room	We refurbished and redecorated the IT suite.
